### TRANSLATIONAL PHYSICIAN PROGRAMME 2025

<b>Objective</b>	The <b>CRIS Translational Physician Programme</b> aims to support clinical researchers in Spain by providing competitive financial conditions and incentives. Each year, CRIS Cancer awards <b>two five-year research grants</b> to recruit clinical scientists to work at hospitals, universities, or research centers in Spain.

### MAJOR CHARACTERISTICS

<b>Support mechanism</b>	Contratos/Becas
<b>Duration</b>	5 years
<b>Financial support</b>	The <b>CRIS Translational Physician Programme</b> offers a <b>€400,000 grant over five years</b> (up to <b>€80,000 annually</b> ) to support clinical researchers in Spain. The grant covers: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Salary:</b> Up to <b>€70,000 per year</b>, with options for salary supplements, work hour intensification, or full coverage for new hires.</li> <li>• <b>Research expenses:</b> Funding for staff, equipment, travel, intellectual property management, and other project-related costs.</li> <li>• <b>Relocation assistance:</b> <b>€5,400</b> for researchers moving to a new city.</li> <li>• <b>Family support:</b> <b>€1,200 per dependent child</b> (up to €2,400 per year).</li> </ul>
<b>Eligibility:</b>	<p><b>Training:</b> Open to specialist physicians with a <b>PhD obtained between January 2015 and October 2025</b>. Proof of PhD completion is required. Extensions may apply under specific circumstances.</p> <p><b>Research Career:</b> Candidates must be <b>first or last author</b> on at least <b>one Q1 journal publication</b> with a PubMed ID. Conference abstracts, preprints, and book chapters do not count.</p> <p><b>Nationality:</b> Open to postdoctoral clinical scientists of any nationality, provided the research is conducted in <b>Spain</b>.</p> <p><b>Research Project:</b> Candidates must present a high-quality research proposal. If applying for the third time with the same project, a new proposal is required.</p> <p><b>Mentor:</b> Candidates must propose <b>one mentor</b>, who does not have to be the project supervisor but should support the candidate's career development. The mentor can be from any institution worldwide.</p> <p><b>Hosting Institution:</b> Must be a <b>hospital, university, or research center in Spain</b>. Only one beneficiary per institution per call.</p>
<b>Incompatibilities</b>	<p>Researchers can apply to only <b>one CRIS Research Programme per call</b> (Excellence, Emerging Leader, or Translational Physician Programme).</p> <p>Previous awardees <b>cannot reapply</b> to the same programme but may apply to a different one in the final year of their grant. Only <b>2021 CRIS Out-Back Programme awardees</b> are eligible for the <b>2025 call</b>.</p> <p><b>Only Spanish hospitals, universities, and research centers</b> can host beneficiaries, with <b>one awardee per institution per call</b>.</p> <p><b>Scientific evaluation board members</b> cannot apply.</p> <p>Applicants <b>previously rejected for scientific integrity issues</b> are ineligible.</p>

### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

<b>How to apply</b>	All applications must be completed on-line using the CRIS Excellence Programme Platform, which will be made available to candidates at <a href="http://www.criscancer.org/programascris">www.criscancer.org/programascris</a> during the application submission period for the 2025 programme. Applicants must register as users on the Platform, which will send them a confirmation email allowing them to access their application.
<b>Application materials</b>	<p>All applications must be <b>submitted in English</b> and include two sections:</p> <p><b>Part A: Administrative Form (to be completed online)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Candidate's <b>personal and academic details</b></li> <li>• Current and <b>host institution</b> information</li> <li>• <b>Mentor's details</b></li> <li>• Research project <b>title, code, area, type of cancer, and duration</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Part B: Documentation (must follow provided templates and not exceed 4 MB per file)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Curriculum Vitae (CV)</b> (maximum 4 pages, standardized format)</li> <li>• <b>Doctoral certificate</b> (or official confirmation of PhD completion date)</li> <li>• <b>Extension request documentation</b> (if applicable, e.g., parental leave, illness)</li> <li>• <b>Research project</b> (maximum 5 pages)</li> <li>• <b>Project budget</b> (Excel template, external financial audit optional)</li> <li>• <b>Candidate's track record</b> (key career achievements, maximum 3 pages)</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Mentor’s acceptance letter</b> (confirming research support)</li> <li>• <b>Mentor’s CV</b> (standardized format)</li> <li>• <b>Host institution acceptance letter</b> (signed by the managing or scientific director)</li> <li>• <b>Ethical declaration</b></li> <li>• <b>One-page project summary in Spanish</b> (patient-friendly explanation)</li> </ul> <p>All documents must be <b>clear, legible PDFs</b>, with translations required for non-English/Spanish documents. Selected candidates have time to confirm or adjust their host institution and research focus, subject to <b>CRIS Cancer’s approval</b>.</p>
