Objective	The CRIS Translational Physician Programme aims to support clinical researchers in Spain by providing competitive financial conditions and incentives. Each year, CRIS Cancer awards <b>two five-year research grants</b> to recruit clinical scientists to work at hospitals, universities, or research centers in Spain.

Financial	The CRIS Translational Physician Programme offers a €400,000 grant over five years (up to €80,000 annually) to	
support	support clinical researchers in Spain. The grant covers:	
Зарроге	<ul> <li>Salary: Up to €70,000 per year, with options for salary supplements, work hour intensification, or full coverage for new hires.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Research expenses: Funding for staff, equipment, travel, intellectual property management, and other project-related costs.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Relocation assistance: €5,400 for researchers moving to a new city.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Family support: €1,200 per dependent child (up to €2,400 per year).</li> </ul>	
Eligibility:	<b>Training</b> : Open to specialist physicians with a <b>PhD obtained between January 2015 and October 2025</b> . Proof of PhD completion is required. Extensions may apply under specific circumstances.	
	Research Career: Candidates must be first or last author on at least one Q1 journal publication with a PubMed ID.	
	Conference abstracts, preprints, and book chapters do not count.  Nationality: Open to postdoctoral clinical scientists of any nationality, provided the research is conducted in Spain.  Research Project: Candidates must present a high-quality research proposal. If applying for the third time with the	
	same project, a new proposal is required.  Mentor: Candidates must propose one mentor, who does not have to be the project supervisor but should support	
	the candidate's career development. The mentor can be from any institution worldwide.  Hosting Institution: Must be a hospital, university, or research center in Spain. Only one beneficiary per institution per call.	
Incompatibilities	Researchers can apply to only <b>one CRIS Research Programme per call</b> (Excellence, Emerging Leader, or Translational Physician Programme).	
	Previous awardees <b>cannot reapply</b> to the same programme but may apply to a different one in the final year of their grant. Only <b>2021 CRIS Out-Back Programme awardees</b> are eligible for the <b>2025 call</b> .	
	Only Spanish hospitals, universities, and research centers can host beneficiaries, with one awardee per institution per call.	
	Scientific evaluation board members cannot apply.  Applicants previously rejected for scientific integrity issues are ineligible.

	Ethical declaration
	One-page project summary in Spanish (patient-friendly explanation)
	All documents must be clear, legible PDFs, with translations required for non-English/Spanish documents.
	Selected candidates have time to confirm or adjust their host institution and research focus, subject to CRIS Cancer's
	approval.
