	PROGRAMA OUT-BACK FELLOWSHIP 2025
Objective	The CRIS Out-Back Fellowship supports scientists and physician researchers who wish to train abroad and later return to Spain to advance their cancer research careers. Open to all nationalities, the program offers competitive financial support and incentives for career development in Spanish research centers, hospitals, or universities. Beyond scientific training, the fellowship includes mentorship and leadership development to prepare awardees as future leaders in cancer research.

Duration	Maximum of 5 years
Financial	The CRIS Out-Back Fellowship provides up to €350,000 over five years (€70,000 per year) to support researcher during their training abroad and return to Spain. The budget covers:
support	• Personnel Costs: Salaries, social security, and taxes (minimum €55,000/year). If local salaries exceed this the host institution must cover other project costs.
	<ul> <li>Allowances (Optional):         <ul> <li>Family support: €1,200 per dependent child (max €2,400/year). If unused, funds can go to research.</li> <li>Mability allowance: €1,200 for releastion</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Mobility allowance: €1,250 for relocation.</li> <li>Other Direct Costs: Research-related expenses, including equipment, travel, intellectual property publications, and training.</li> </ul>
	Funds are managed by the <b>host institutions</b> , which must <b>justify spending annually</b> . <b>Indirect costs are not covered</b> The researcher is the named beneficiary and must comply with legal employment regulations.
Eligibility:	<ul> <li>Education &amp; Experience: Open to cancer researchers with a PhD earned after January 2020 or 4-9 years of full time experience in cancer research.</li> <li>Mobility Rule: Candidates must not have lived or worked in the Outgoing Stage country for more than 13</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>months in the past 3 years (since January 2022).</li> <li>Nationality: Open to all nationalities.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Research &amp; Training Requirements</li> <li>Applicants must provide their research track record, publications, and a career development plan detailin</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>future training, skills, and secondments.</li> <li>Fellows must attend training and mentoring sessions and are encouraged to participate in institutional training</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>networking events, and skill-building programs.</li> <li>Candidates must submit a high-quality research proposal focused on a specific research line.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Supervision &amp; Hosting Institutions</li> <li>Each applicant must have a primary supervisor at both the Outgoing and Return host institutions.</li> </ul>
	• The Outgoing Stage must last at least 2 years in a foreign institution.
	• The Return Stage must be at a Spanish institution for 1-2 years.
Incompatibilities	Applicants can only receive one CRIS Out-Back Fellowship. Peer-review and Interview Panel members cannot apply.
	Mobility restrictions apply as stated above.
How to apply	APPLICATION PROCEDURE All applications must be completed on-line using the CRIS Excellence Programme Platform, which will be
	made available to candidates at www.criscancer.org/programascris during the application submission period for the 2025 programme. Applicants must register as users on the Platform, which will send them a confirmation email allowing them to access their application.

	11. Mobility Rule Compliance – Confirming the candidate has not lived or worked in the Outgoing country

	All applications must be completed during the <b>2025 call submission period</b> . Candidates will receive a <b>confirmation</b>	
	email upon registration.
